The Rainbow Lorikeet came into aviculture in 1770 when Tupaia, a Tahitian ship-man sailed with Captain Cook to Botany Bay, captured one as part of a collection of birds destined for Joseph Banks in England. Tupaia kept the bird, but died of typhus on the way back to England. Banks gave it to Marmaduke Tunstall for his menagerie of exotic birds at Wycliffe. It lived there for some time and finally found a place in his museum.
